Tacoma and much of Pierce County is one of only 32 communities in the country that doesn't meet federal standards for certain types of air pollution. During winter, wood smoke plays a large part in the fine particle pollution problem that plagues our region.

BURN BAN ENFORCEMENT HAS INCREASED.

Burn bans will be actively enforced, particularly in the Smoke Reduction Zone. Wood burning during a ban may result in a significant fine.
